2. Algaecide treatment-There will be two copper based algaecide treatments. The first will be liquid copper solution. The second will take place two weeks later and will be Komeen Crystals (also copper based).
3. Pre and post treatment surveys will be done by Dr. Larkin with the U of M to determine the effectiveness of the treatment.

## *Schedule*

Chris explained that treatment is expected to start October 19<sup>th</sup>, 22 days after the DNR confirmed the presence of starry stonewort on Lake Sylvia.

The access will only be closed for treatment which should take a total of three weeks.
