Five Principles of Soil Health

- Keep the soil covered
- Minimize soil disturbance
- Increase crop diversity
- Keep living roots in the soil
- Integrate livestock

Wright SWCD

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The Wright SWCD is promoting the adoption of soil health practices in Wright County.

- Practices eligible for cost-share assistance are cover crops, no-till and strip-till, and perennial grain crops
- Landowners who participate will receive direct payments for the number of acres planned and implemented with these practices
- Payments range from \$20 to \$65 per acre
- Contract options
 - Annual contract payments up to \$5,000
 - Multi-year contract payments up to \$15,000
